

Alliance Children's Church Polices, Guidelines and Procedures

Age- Alliance Children's Church is for grades Kindergarten to 6th. (* Contact Children's Director for exceptions on age with siblings depending on self-care, maturity/ability, etc.).

Arrival- Attendance is taken, and names are registered. Head count taken if we enter or leave rooms.

Phone Numbers & Contact Information- All parents must leave their phone number if a permission slip is not on file (communication during service, if needed). If you are a guest, please fill out a "New to Children's Church Form" located at the front of the sanctuary and children should carry this to Children's Church with them. Once the form is completed child will have a lanyard for class with their information on it.

Volunteer Agreement – All volunteers must complete Ministry Safe training. If a volunteer has not completed training, they will not be left alone with your child without a Ministry Safe trained employee or volunteer. Youth volunteers are never left alone with children.

Bathroom Policy – Every child participating in Children's Church should be able to care for themselves in the restroom. Employee's and Volunteers are to wait in the hallway or outside the bathroom doors.

CPR & First Aid Training- Alliance Children's Church Director will have a current CPR & First aid license.

Allergies- Parents must make the Director aware of any allergies (food, latex, etc.). Please see the allergy question on the "New to Children's Church Form" (located front of the sanctuary).

Permission Slips – Permission slips are not required for Sunday School or Zoom calls. However, permission slips are required for any children's event that parents drop child off and leave the property, and off-property events.

Fire & Emergency – In the event of a fire or indoor emergency, we will exit the building to the ball field area.

COVID-19 Procedures- All children are encouraged to wear a mask. ACC Director and volunteers are required to wear masks. Children's hands are sanitized repeatedly during class. All supplies are wiped down after use along with tables and chairs. We also try to sit no more than two to a table or keep them with siblings and spread out as much as possible while on the floor. We do try to stay in more open spaces, open loft area with open doors, playground, picnic table, and Family Life Center (Gym).
